PRIVACY PROTECTION AND PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING INFORMATION

Amagasaki Pipe Czech s.r.o., Japonská 461, 331 44 Kožlany, as the data controller, in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation; GDPR), provides information on the processing of personal data of suppliers and other entities involved in business relationships with Amagasaki.

1. INITIATING COLLABORATION

a) Basis of Processing

New buyers are sent a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) before negotiations commence. Upon collaboration, the supplier/buyer becomes a registered entity in the Amagasaki system. Processing of personal data occurs in connection with contract fulfillment.

b) Processing Scope

Data necessary for contract closure and execution are processed, including name, surname, identification numbers, address, contact details, bank account numbers, and other payment information. Collaboration may require the provision of references.

c) Obtaining Personal Data

Data is primarily obtained from the supplier/buyer; verification may involve public registers such as the trade register, insolvency register, and commercial register.

Suppliers are obliged to provide accurate information and update it in case of changes.

d) Nature of Processing

Personal data is processed manually by employees and authorized individuals. Automated processing involves the use of an ERP system and quality management system.

e) Processing Duration

Personal data is processed during the collaboration. After collaboration ends, data is retained for accounting, archiving, and in accordance with legitimate interests (e.g., protection against claims or relationships with intellectual property).

2. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

Right to access personal data and obtain a copy.

Right to information about processing purposes, categories of data, recipients, planned processing duration, and other details.

Right to explanation, correction, processing restriction, erasure, and data portability. Right to lodge a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection.

3. PROCESSING COMMITMENTS

Transmitting personal data to third parties requires informing and potentially entering into a personal data processing agreement.

4. CONTACT PERSONS

Persons working for suppliers/buyers may be transferred to Amagasaki; suppliers are obligated to inform these individuals about the extent of data processing.

5. DATA TRANSFER AND PROTECTION

Microsoft Corporation's services are used for personal data processing. Data may be disclosed to public authorities, advisors, and within the Amagasaki holding structure.

6. DATA PROTECTION

Data is safeguarded using antivirus protection, firewalls, encryption, authorization credentials, and backups.
